## Request for Proposals - Videographer

**The Roman Catholic Archdiocese of Regina is seeking a videographer**, an individual or company, who can help visually tell the stories of the Archdiocese. The Archdiocese will accept proposals from an individual or company, to provide video content, from planning and filming to production, to be used throughout the Archdiocese of Regina. Total project time is expected to average approximately 16-20 hours per month.

Projects include, but are not limited to, the annual Archbishop's Appeal, the Archbishop's various messages throughout the year, video coverage of stories and projects, working with diocesan staff to develop and conduct interviews for projects, and live streaming of diocesan events as determined by diocesan leadership. All video and still footage as well as completed projects would become the property of the Archdiocese of Regina. Some travel throughout the Archdiocese of Regina will be expected. The successful candidate will provide their own equipment for filming and production.

Interested parties should include with their proposal:

- A brief understanding of video production as a ministry;
- A proposed total cost for 1 year;
- A breakdown of that cost per month and per hour;
- Details of any of the work that would be sub-contracted, how subcontracting would be handled, and by whom;
- Examples of filming and production work, along with references for such examples.
