The Cana Family Retreat Vacation is a time for Catholic families to get together with other Catholic families to share their Catholic Faith. The camp is located at the Watson Homestead in rural upstate New York. The Homestead offers a beautiful, serene setting. The Cana Retreat Vacation is located in the Retreat Center cabins. There are three cabins which are divided to house four small families or two large families in each cabin. Each cabin has bathrooms with showers and a main gathering area with a refrigerator for snacks and such. There is a recreation hall in the center of the compound.

Our Retreat Vacation is an opportunity for families to spend time together in a Catholic Christians setting. All meals are provided. Families are asked to bring bedding, (sleeping bags will do nicely), towels, and toiletries. We ask that all electronic games, computers and other devices be left home. Cell phones should be used for emergencies only. The week will begin with an orientation on Sunday evening and conclude with Mass on Saturday morning.

We ask a \$50.00 non-refundable deposit with your registration. Because we believe that all families need a week like this, we do not want to exclude anyone because of cost. Therefore, you will be asked to make a free will offering at the end of the week. We will tell you our costs on request. If you can afford to pay more and think it is worth it, we thank you for your support. If you cannot afford very much we will be grateful for your presence and anything you can give.
