Dying Healed: What is it?

- We cannot heal everyone physically, but we can help to heal emotionally and spiritually.
- ♣ We can educate lay people to be confident in their presence at the bedside of a lonely or dying person.
- Dying for lack of love should never happen.

Dying Healed: What it is NOT?

- **♣** DH does not replace any other volunteer program.
- DH is not training professional counsellors, advisors, mediators.
- DH does not replace medical advice.
- ♣ DH does not train people to be confrontational or to proselytize.
- DH is not a pre-training volunteer recruitment program.

Program Structure

- ♣ DH is an 8 hour program that is usually offered in two 4-hour sessions or four 2- hour sessions.
- Cost: \$25.00 per participant. Cost includes workbook, food and facilities.
- Workshop includes lecture, discussion and videos.
