Protocol

1. Where can I find more information on the June 6th Protocol workshop? **The June 6th Protocol and Administrative Workshop scheduled for June has been cancelled. We hope to host a workshop of this nature in the fall.**
2. When are you coming to audit our Protocol Records? **The Protocol department will be auditing only the protocol records of parishes that we have previously contacted. We will be sending out a schedule next week.**
3. What if we are not on the list but want a protocol audit? **That is no problem. Just contact us (see above) and we can arrange a visit.**
4. What do I do with those in High Security Ministers that are negligent in updating their Criminal Record Check? **As harsh as this sounds, those individuals not providing a current Criminal Record Check MUST have privileges suspended until a current and clear Criminal Record Check is provided. There are NO exceptions.**
