Dear priests, sisters, deacons, and lay faithful of the Archdiocese of Regina:

With gratitude for the work of the Personnel Committee, we are pleased to announce the following appointments in the Archdiocese of Regina which are effective August 1, 2018 (a second memo with additional changes is forthcoming):
