

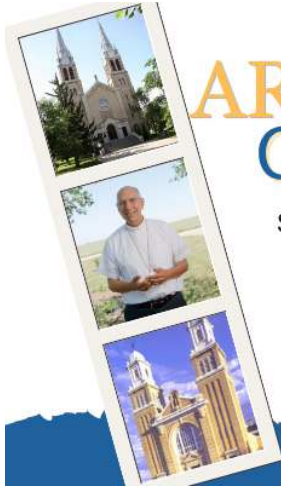

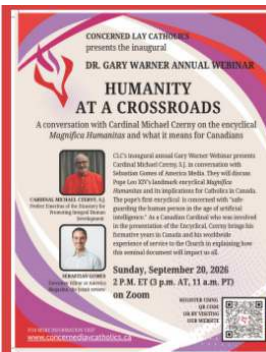

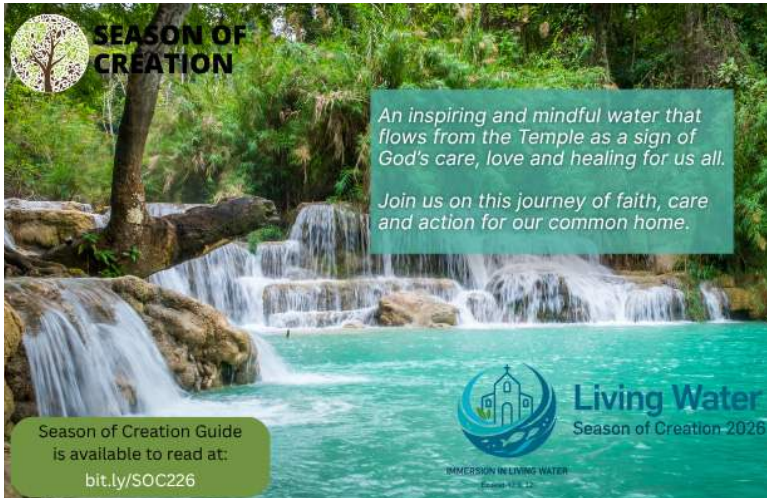
Catholic Engaged Encounter
